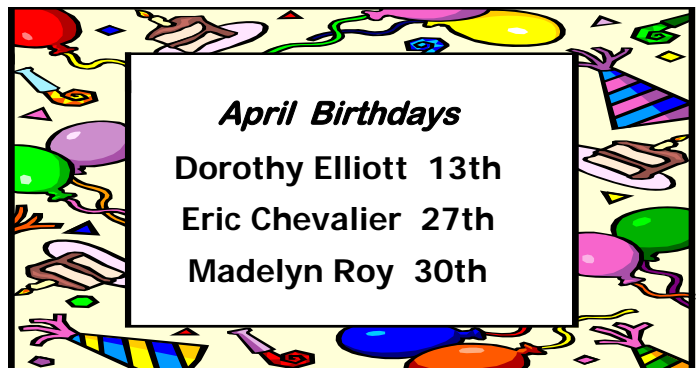

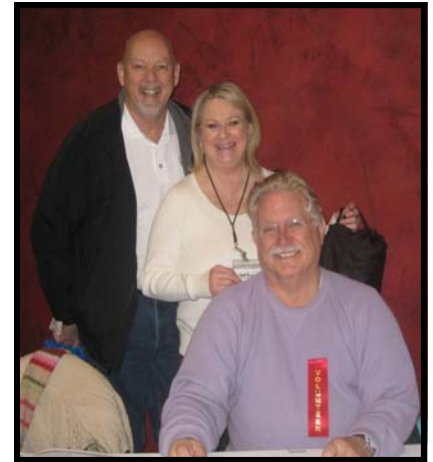


More Dreambuilders Gala pictures
